Upon due consideration, it is ORDERED that the motion for in forma pauperis status and free transcripts is DENIED as unnecessary. The appellant already has in forma pauperis status on appeal. See 2d CIR. DKT. SHT. (No. 06-2494-cr); 2D CIR. R 4(b)(b) (providing that " this [C]ourt may accept the Distrcit Court`s finding that the defendant is financially unable to employ counsel an no further proof of the defendent`s indigency need be submitted unless specifically required"). Transcripts must be provided for the appellant. See, e.g., Griffin v. Illinois, 351 U.S. 12, 18-19 (1956) (plurality opinion).  
Glenn Edward Murray, whom the district court appointed pursuant to the Criminal Justice Act("CJA"), 18 U.S.C. 3006A, to represent the appellant in a standby capacity, shall continue as standby counsel, until relieved by this Court. See 18 U.S.C. 3006A(c); 2D CIR. R. 4(b)(a). It is ORDERED that Counsel, within seven (7) days of the entry of this ruling, order that th trial transcripts, and any other necessary papers, be prepared and "delivered within 7 calender days after reciept of [counsel`s] order." 2D CIR. INSTRUCTIONS FOR AUTHORIZATION AND VOUCHER FOR PAYMENT OF TRANSCRIPT CJA FORM24, Item 14.  
It is further ORDERED that the appellant`s motion to be released pending appel is DEFERRED pending receipt of the necessary transcripts. Upon this Court`s receipt of the necessary transcripts, Counsel may, if he so wishes, file a motion to be relieved as standby counsel, but, prior to doing so, he must"advise the defendant must promptly obtain other counsel unless the defendant desires to proceed pro se and that if the

defendant is financially unable to obtain counsel, a lawyer may be appointed by this court under the Criminal Justice Act." 2C CIR. R. 4(b)(c). If the appellant wishes to appear pro se, then Counsel must then file, along with his motion to be relieved, "[a]n affidavit or signed statement showing that the defendant has been advised that the defendant may retain new counsel or apply for appointment of counsel and expressly stating that the defendant does not wish to be represented by counsel but elects to appear pro se." 2D CIR. R. 4(b)(d)(3). The process helps to assure this Court that the appellant has been properly informed if his constitutional right to appellate counsel-in a standby capacity or otherwise." Standby counsel should ascertain whether appellant has obtained copies of the transcripts of trial proceedings filed in the district court in May 2007. Counsel shall inform the Court by letter within twenty days of the entry of this ruling whether appellant has received the transcripts sought by this motion, as well as any other transcripts to which he is entitled pursuant to the district court's September 11, 2006 order.
